

## **December 2023 CAPA News – Concerns about Uploading Images**

**Response:** Thank you for these suggestions, and we appreciate the opportunity to address each which are included in the responses below:

### **A. Clean up the entry & recording system. Unable to see if you receive my pictures or not.**

Most camera clubs in southwestern Ontario and elsewhere in the world are utilize the current version of the EntryWizard online competition.

CAPA, has successfully employed this system for the past six years, meeting and surpassing our photo competition requirements.

To ensure seamless operation and address any concerns, we have a dedicated EntryWizard Specialist on our competition team and assists with the configuration of the system to meet our changing requirements. EntryWizard has proven to be a reliable and stable platform over the past six years.

Regarding the image upload process in EntryWizard, it functions appropriately, providing error messages an image fails to meet the specified dimensions or in the case of a system error.

While some other online photo competitions systems notify entrants upon successful image upload, the EntryWizard system currently lacks this feature. We do not perceive a necessity to hire a programmer to add this function.

During the image upload process for our competition, it is essential to wait for the upload bar, located beneath the last uploaded image, to reach

100% before navigating away from the competition upload window. Refer to the accompanying screen capture image below, which highlights the 100% maker and the image load bar.
