**Response:** Thank you for these suggestions, and we appreciate the opportunity to address each which are included in the responses below:

As noted above, the prevailing sentiment among survey respondents suggests a preference for an increased number of competitions rather than a reduction.

Recognizing the significant workload borne by our dedicated volunteers in overseeing both national and zone competitions, the Board of Directors proposed a strategic limitation of the total annual competitions of 13. These competitions are slated to take place from October 1 to early May each year.

In addition to these 13 competitions, our volunteers also oversees the selection of our top 80 images annually, representing Canada in the inter-society Four Nations competition.

Outlined in our "March 2024 Suggestions for New Competitions" document is our commitment to adhering to the specified maximum of 13 competitions while ensuring a diverse array of competitions. This approach aims to accommodate a broad spectrum

of photographer interests by incorporation various photo genres within each competition.
